# Beman Wins Porter Cup

Deane Beman, the 26-year-old National Amateur Golf Champion from Bethesda, MD isn't the type to let pressure bother him, and that's probably one of the big reasons he is regarded as the best non-professional golfer in the world.

It's also the reason he won the Alex Porter Cup at the Niagara Falls Country Club.

Beman, a business-like 5-foot, 7-inch insurance man with a crew haircut, overcame a final-round six on the par-5, 17<sup>th</sup> hole where he hit his second shot out of bounds. Despite the bogey, Beman would shoot a final round 68 for a 72-hole total of 277 to nip Jim Grant III of Wethersfield, CT by a stroke.

On the last hole, the hushed gallery surrounding the green watched intently as Grant had an opportunity to tie. However, his 15-foot birdie attempt slid by harmlessly thus giving Beman the title.
