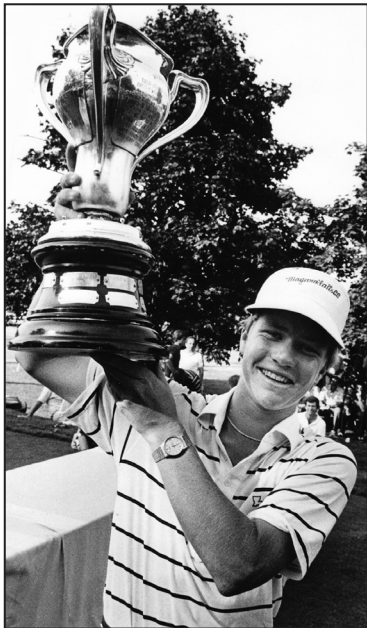


# 'Great show' for Verplank



## Slipko, Silver keep up heat in Porter Cup

Mike Slipko and Fred Silver had the "home court" advantage, but it was Scott Verplank who had the better golf shots as he won the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Porter Cup in style.

The NCAA All-American from Oklahoma State fended off the double challenge of Slipko and Silver and the sentiments of one of the largest galleries in recent years to win the tourney by three strokes.

Verplank converted a clutch five-foot putt at the 17<sup>th</sup> which setup his victory march down the 18<sup>th</sup> fairway.
