Henke came and conquered

Florida State senior's 68 wins Porter Cup by 1 stroke

Nolan Henke came to the Porter Cup tournament well-rested, but unheralded. Now he can rest easy and savor his first major amateur victory, a one-stroke triumph over Mike Bradley that should give him some prominence among his peers.

Henke was hardly ever in trouble during the final round at NFCC on his way to a two-under 68 that gave him a 72-hole total of 273.

Bradley, who was tied with Henke going into the last round, struggled through the front nine in 3-over par 38 before rallying on the back nine to make it exciting. It was Bradley's second straight runner-up finish in the Porter Cup.
