

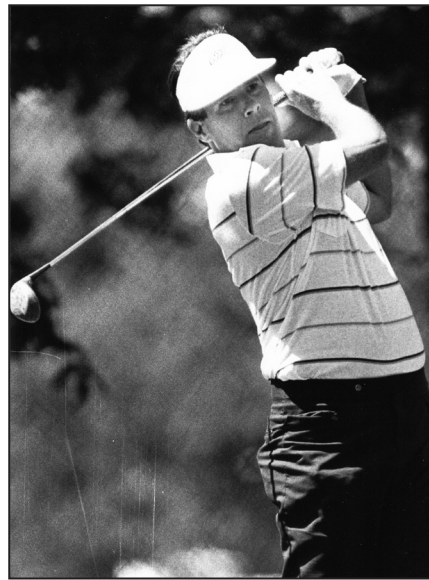

If there ever was a Porter Cup that should have ended in a tie, this was it. Berwyn, PA native Jay Sigel, playing in his 22nd tournament at NFCC and Nacho Gervas, playing in his first, waged an entertaining battle for 20 holes before Sigel prevailed.



Jay Sigel continued a pattern of winning every six years after recording Porter Cup victories in 1975 and 1981

Sigel rallied from four strokes down to tie Gervas on the 15th hole with a difficult birdie putt. Gervas, a 22-year-old senior at Georgia Tech, scrambled for pars at the difficult 16th, 17th and 18th holes to force the playoff matching Sigel's 2-under par score of 278.

After both parred the par-4 first with difficult up-and-downs, the duo headed to the 2nd hole where Gervas pulled his drive left under a stand of trees. He nubbed his second shot out into the rough and his approach shot bounced long over the green. Sigel was then able to lag his birdie attempt for a tap-in par and his record third green jacket.
