Porter Cup's a wash

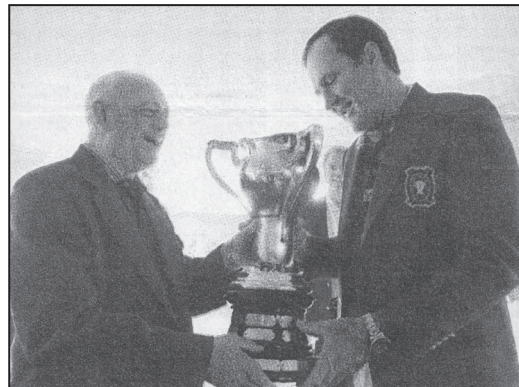
Doyle named champ as rain cancels final round

The stage was set for one of those fantastic finishes at the 36th Porter Cup. The kind of finish golf fans and players love, where each shot is crucial. The kind of finish that generates the pressure that will separate the contenders from the pretenders.

But it wasn't to be. For the first time in history, the tournament had to be shortened to 54 holes because the NFCC course was more suited for jet skis than golf clubs. Heavy rain that began around 10 am soaked an already soft course forcing tournament officials to call it off and declare Allen Doyle of LaGrange, GA, the winner.

"Unfortunately, they don't have any control over the weather and neither do I," said Doyle. "A win is a win."

He won by a stroke over Chris Riley, Christian Chernock and Robert Floyd, son of touring pro Raymond Floyd. Riley, the leader after two rounds, bogeyed the final hole of his third round after missing a four-foot putt, thus denying him a share of the lead.
