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# Snyder takes Porter Cup

## Champ holds off late charge for win

Joey Snyder is a rookie when it comes to winning golf tournaments. And it showed for a while during the final round at NFCC.

Snyder, a Tempe, AZ resident who was born in Buffalo, came into the final round with a five-stroke lead that was extended to seven with chip-ins at the fifth and sixth holes. His ragged finish on the last five holes gave runner-up John Curley some hope, but Snyder hung on to win.

"Going to the last tee, I thought I had a two-or-three stroke lead," Snyder said. "I just wanted to hit it to the front of the green, if I could just two-putt, just get it in the hole, tap it....anything. I was really nervous down the stretch."
